1.0 ELIGIBILITY OF TENDERER :

The minimum eligibility criteria for tenderer shall be as follows:-

1.0.1 Manufacturer of the products

Or

Sole Selling Agent / Authorized Dealer / Authorized Distributor /Sub Dealer for the products of reputed manufacturer

Or

Supplier of similar type of products

Documentary evidence for the above should be enclosed with the quotation.

1.0.2 In addition, the bidder has to submit the following:

Photocopy of Permanent Account Number Card (PAN).

Photocopy of TIN/Sales tax Registration Certificate.

1.1 SUBMISSION OF TENDER :

Tenderers are required to submit their offers in a single sealed envelope giving reference to the Tender Notice No. and date. The single sealed envelope shall contain offers in two separate envelopes properly sealed and superscribed as Envelope - I and Envelope - II respectively. Both envelopes as well as the single envelope containing the two envelopes must be properly sealed. Envelopes sealed by way of stapler only shall not be accepted.

The tenderers should sign with seal on all pages of tender document including all enclosures submitted with the tender. Offers received without signature and seal on all pages shall be rejected.

Two envelopes should contain the details of the offer as follows:

Envelope- I (Technical) - Should contain the following –

- i) Tender document, duly signed in all pages by the tenderer, issued by department.
- ii) All the requisite documents mentioned above at Sl. No. 1.0 (eligibility of tenderer).
- iii) EMD in the form of demand draft/cash receipt.

Envelope- II (Price) - Should contain rates only in the format as indicated in this tender document (Annexure –III)

1.2 Opening of Offers -

Envelope – I (Commercial bid) will be opened by the tender committee on due date & time of opening of tender.

Envelope – II (Price bid) of the offers shall be opened by the tender committee only in respect of such tenders as are found valid after scrutiny of Envelope – I.

Date and time of opening of Envelope – II of successful tenderers will be communicated by the tender committee in due course.

Tender must be submitted in sealed covers, which must be superscribed with the Tender Number and the date of opening.



Quotations, erased and over written, will be summarily rejected.

Conditional offer will not be considered.

The prices offered should be given both in words and figures.

The rate shall be quoted on FOR destination basis with breakup of prices.

Details of Prices, Discounts, Taxes and Duties should be indicated in the Price Bid. If no mention is made about various taxes, duties, levies etc. and their applicability to be charged extra / or exclusive, then it will be presumed to be included in prices quoted.

Note : Tenderer should furnish their sales tax registration number (Central / State) and date in the quotation / Invoice.

All tenderers should furnish self attested & stamped Sales-Tax / VAT Registration certificate with appropriate Authority

1.3 Quotation may be submitted for individual item or group of items as mentioned in Annexure-I.

1.4 DECLARATION REGARDING BANNING/DELISTING : The bidder should give a declaration, as per Annexure-VI, that they have not been banned or delisted by any Govt. or Quasi Govt. Agencies or PSUs. If a bidder has been banned / delisted by any Govt. of Quasi Govt. Agencies or PSUs, the fact must be clearly stated. In case the tenderer has been banned / delisted and this fact is not declared, the bid will be rejected as non-responsive.

1.5 DEVIATION : Deviations sought by bidders, whether these are Commercial or Technical deviations, must only be given in the schedules prescribed for them. Any willful attempt by the bidders to camouflage the deviations by giving them on the covering letter or in any other documents than the prescribed schedules may render the bidder itself non-responsive.

Tender, received on or before due date and time will be considered only.

Tenders sent through Telex, Fax or E-Mail will not be considered.

Tender Documents are not transferable.

The company reserves the right to cancel the whole tendering process at any stage without assigning any reason what so ever.

2.0.0 COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.0.1 Consignee: Regional Director, CMPDI, RI-IV, Nagpur.

2.0.2 Bill accepting authority: RD, CMPDI, RI-IV or his authorized representative.

2.0.3 Paying authority: HOD (Finance), CMPDI, RI-IV, Nagpur.

2.0.4 PRICES : The prices quoted must be firm throughout delivery and FOR destination. The quotation should be inclusive of installation and commissioning of material.

2.0.5 VALIDITY OF OFFER : Offers must remain open for acceptance for six months (180 days) from the due date of opening of the tender.



- 2.0.6 The lowest bidder will be decided on the basis of lowest bids against individual items including installation & commissioning of materials at Env. Lab., CMPDI, Nagpur.
- 2.0.7 **PAYMENT TERM** : 100% payment will be made within 21 days after satisfactory supply, inspection, installation & commissioning and acceptance of the supplied materials against supply order on submission of bill. The supplier is required to furnish all the necessary documents required for e-payments of bill.
- 2.0.8 **DELIVERY** : All the materials shall be delivered with in 6-8 weeks from the date of placement of supply order. The time for and the date of delivery of stores stipulated in the Supply Order shall be deemed to be of the essence of the contract and delivery of the stores must be completed by the date specified. In the event of failure to deliver or despatch the stores within the stipulated date/period in accordance with the specification mentioned in the Supply Order and in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the Supply Order, CMPDI has the right to initiate action as per Liquidated Damages Clause specified at Clause 2.0.9 below.
- 2.0.9 Liquidated Damages Clause** : In the event of failure to deliver or dispatch the stores within the stipulated date/period in accordance with the specifications mentioned in the supply order and in the event of breach of any of the terms and conditions mentioned in the supply order, Coal India Ltd. and its subsidiary Companies should have the right :
- (a) To recover from the successful tenderer as agreed liquidated damages, a sum not less than 0.5% (half percent) of the price of any stores which the successful tenderer has not been able to supply as aforesaid for each week or part of a week during which the delivery of such stores may be in arrears limited to 10%. Where felt necessary the limit of 10% can be increased to 15% at the discretion of Head of the Materials Management Division.
 - (b) To purchase elsewhere, after due notice to the successful tenderer on the account and at the risk of the defaulting supplier the stores not supplied or others of a similar description without canceling the supply in respect of the consignment not yet due for supply; or
 - (c) To cancel the supply order or a portion thereof, and if so desired to purchase the stores at the risk and cost of the defaulting supplier; and also
 - (d) To extend the period of delivery with or without penalty as may be considered fit and proper, the penalty, if imposed shall not be more than the agreed Liquidated Damages referred in clause (a) above.
 - (e) To forfeit the Security Deposit full or in part.
 - (f) Whenever under this contract a sum of money is recoverable from any payable by the supplier, Coal India Limited and its Subsidiary Companies shall be entitled to recover such sum by appropriating, in part or in whole by deducting any sum or any other contract should this sum be not sufficient to cover the full amount recoverable, the successful tenderer shall pay Coal India Limited and its subsidiary companies on demand in remaining balance. The supplier shall not be entitled any gain on any such purchase.
- 2.0.10 **INSPECTION** : Materials are subject to inspection by inspection authorities to be deputed for the purpose at Consignee's end. It may be carried out before despatch, if required. Even after pre-despatch inspection is carried out the materials will be subject to final inspection at site after receipt of materials at site.

- 2.0.11 **REPLACEMENT OF REJECTED MATERIALS** : The rejected materials should be replaced within 15 days from the date of issue of Material Rejection Note. If rejected materials are not replaced within the said period, CMPDI has the right to initiate action as per Liquidated Damages Clause 2.0.9.
- 2.0.12 **PACKING** : The packing of all the materials quoted shall confirm to the requirements of the carrier.
- 2.0.13 **GUARANTEE/WARRANTY** : The tenderers shall give warranty of satisfactory performance of the equipment offered by them for a period of 12 months from the date of commissioning or 18 months from the date of receipt and acceptance by CMPDI.
The supplier shall be responsible for any defects that they develop under the conditions provided for by the contract and under proper use, arising from faulty materials, design or workmanship and shall remedy such defects at his own cost when called upon to do so. If it becomes necessary for the supplier to replace or renew any defective portion of the goods, such replacement or renewal should be made by the supplier without any extra cost to CMPDI. The goods should properly fit in/on/to the machine for which the same are intended.
- 2.0.14 **PRICE FALL CLAUSE** : It will be a condition of the contract that all through the currency of the prices at which the successful tenderer shall supply the stores, shall not exceed the lowest price charged by them to any other Agency including DGS&D. In the event of price going down, the supplier shall promptly pass such information to enable this company to amend the order rate.
- 2.0.15 **EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT (EMD)** : Earnest Money should be submitted along with Part-I of the offer i.e. (Techno-commercial Bid) in the form of **Bank Draft drawn in favour of "CMPDI, RI-IV, Nagpur payable at Nagpur. In case Earnest Money is not submitted along with Part-I of the tender, the offer shall be out rightly rejected without any reference on this subject.** EMD shall be refunded to the unsuccessful tenderers after finalization of the tender. For successful tenderer EMD will be converted to Security Money which will be refunded to the firm within 30 days of the satisfactory execution of the contract. However EMD shall be forfeited in the following circumstances;
- If any tenderer withdraws their offer before finalization of tender.
 - If the tenderer fails to submit the order acceptance within 15 days from the date of the order.
- 2.0.16 **SECURITY DEPOSIT** : The successful tenderers will be required to deposit as Security Money 10% of the value of order (FOR destination price including taxes and duties) in the form of **Demand Draft drawn in favour of CMPDI, RI-IV, Nagpur, payable at Nagpur** within 15 days from the date of issue of Supply Order if applicable.
- (a) In case tenderer fails to deposit Security Money within the stipulated period the order shall be cancelled and EMD deposited against this tender shall be forfeited. Simultaneous action will be processed to order elsewhere at the risk and cost of the tenderer and their performance shall be kept in record for future dealings.
 - (b) The Security Deposit will be forfeited in case of unsatisfactory performance and/or contractual failure.
 - (c) State/Central govt. Organisation/PSU & the firms registered with DGS&D/NSIC (for the tendered items) will be exempted from depositing Earnest Money/Security Deposit if the firm produces documentary evidence issued by Govt. Authority for according such exemption
