supporting documents which prove that turnover of their business is less than 20 Lakhs and certificate from practicing Chartered Accountant having certificate of Practice and valid membership number of ICAI that Aggregate turnover from all business is less than 20 Lakh, hence he is exempted from Registration under GST Act, 2017.

- c) If bidder is eligible for charging lower than the normal rate is applicable (where Bidder has opted Composition Scheme), then bidder has to submit the authentic documents for such.
- d) The legally applicable rate of CGST/SGST/IGST/ Cess should be clearly mentioned.
- e) In case of COMPOSITION TAX, the supplier is liable to pay tax at concessional rate but can't collect any tax from CMPDIL and on the invoice, it should be mentioned by the supplier that "composition taxable person not eligible collect tax on supplies" The supplier shall be entirely responsible for all taxes and other such levies imposed as per GST or by any other law by government from time to time, including all Bank Charges.
- f) The supplier also shall comply the provisions of GST including "Anti Profiteering clause" of GST.

Supplier shall ensure timely submission of correct invoice(s) as per GST rules/ regulation, with all required supporting document(s) within a period specified in contract to enable CMPDIL to avail input credit of GST (CGST & SGST/UTGST or IGST). If input tax credit is not available to CMPDIL for any reason which is not attributable to CMPDIL, then CMPDIL shall not be obligated or liable to pay or reimburse GST (CGST & SGST/UTGST or IGST) together with all penalties and interest, if any, against any amounts paid or payable by CMPDIL to the contractor.

Tender must be submitted in sealed cover which must be super scribed with the Tender Enquiry Number and the date of opening. Full Name and address of the bidder shall be written on the bottom left corner of the sealed cover. The tender document shall become the property of the Company and shall not be returned to the bidder.

All envelopes containing the tenders shall be properly sealed. The Tender is to be submitted in two parts viz. Part - I and Part - II in separate sealed envelope super scribed by Part -I and Part -II. **The Envelope- I containing Part-I & Envelope-II containing Part-II should be inside one outer cover.** The outer cover shall bear the address of the purchaser and full Name and address of the bidder shall be written on the bottom left corner.

The Tender should be submitted in two parts in two Envelope system and shall be in one outer cover. The first envelope i.e., **Part - I** of the tender document shall contain credentials (duly authenticated by the bidder) in support of his qualification in accordance with Eligibility criteria along with the Earnest Money Receipt/ Demand Draft (in a separate envelope), then put both the document inside first envelope **Part I**). The second envelope i.e., **Part - II** shall contain duly filled in Price Bid. Then, both the PART-I (**Techno Commercial Bid**) and PART-II (**Price bid**). No tender shall be considered unless accompanied by the said Earnest Money.

Each page of the tender document should be signed by the tenderer. This will not contain any alternative items or suggestions, comments, or conditions. Late tender / incomplete tenders / telegraph tenders, tenders received through Post/ courier services or tenders received after due date and time of tender submission shall not be accepted. The Earnest Money will be retained in case of successful bidder and refunded to the unsuccessful

bidder(s) in due course and it will not carry any interest. The EMD of the successful bidder will be dealt with as provided elsewhere in the tender document.

The rate for the work should be inclusive of all incidentals, overheads, taxes, octroi, duties, leads, lifts, carriage, etc. as required for supply, execution and completion of work. It shall be deemed that the bidder(s) has/have visited the site/ area and got fully acquainted with the working and other prevalent conditions thereof and fluctuations thereto whether he/she/they actually visited the site /area or not, and have taken all the above factors into account while quoting rates. The work to be done in office with minimum disturbance to office activities.

Evaluation of bid shall be based on total value of the entire job including supplies of materials as specified in schedule of price and not on individual items.



All the bidders requested to be present on the scheduled date and time of opening. However their absence will not stop opening.

Auto Extension of Critical Date:

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SCOPE OF WORK

Ref: Supply of materials & Installation of power supply arrangement through Fresh Electrical Wiring of Qtr.No:- D/10, Sec-VIII, at Koyla Nagar, Dhanbad.

- a) Supply and installation of one no 63amp MCCB, Main Switch for receiving single phase 230V power at Garage room of quarter.
- b) Supply & Installation of two nos distribution board each containing 40amp & 25 amp MCBs with suitable size of enclosure in the garage for distribution of power and lighting line to ground floor and 1st floor.
- c) Supply & Installation of Distribution boards of proper size containing 40A, DP and 20A, SP switches (of MCBs) for power line and & 25A, DP and 10A, Single pole switches (of MCBs) for lighting ckt. at ground floor and first floor of the building with adequate spare switches.
- d) Power from main Garage to above two nos of power distribution board will be fed by Separate proper size of 16/10 mm² 3core Cu Cable.
- e) Power point will be provided at all Bedrooms, Kitchen room, Bathrooms and Drawing room of each quarter.
- f) Each room will have one fan point, three light points, and One 6 amp 5 pin socket and outside light point if required.
- g) Corridor, verandah & stairs and roof will be also provided with sufficient no of light points.
- h) All distribution boards shall be provided with DP / SP MCBs as outgoing. Separate neutral bus shall be provided for distribution boards.
- i) All bus bars and inter-connectors shall be suitable for full load current capacity. The bus bars and inter-connectors shall be covered with color coded insulation tapes. The bus bars shall be supported on unbreakable non-hygroscopic insulated supports at regular intervals to withstand the short circuit condition of the system. All bus bars shall be provided in separate chambers and shall be properly ventilated.
- j) All distribution boards and bus bar arrangements shall be enclosed in metal boxes with anticorrosive paints.
- k) The distribution boards shall contain plug in or bolted type MCBs mounted on bus bars. MCBs shall be quick make and quick break type with trip free mechanism. The MCBs shall have thermal and magnetic short circuit protection.
- l) All joints shall be made in distribution boards and switch boards only. Conductors shall be continuous from outlet to outlet.
- m) Supply and installation of necessary MS box of proper sizes (with phenolic laminated sheet) in all rooms, bathrooms, kitchen room, Drawing room etc. (wherever required) with 5 pin type 230 volts 6 amps off white socket and piano type switch of reputed make.
- n) Proper earthing work shall be done throughout the installation work following IE rules and Indian standard code of practice .All non-current carrying metal parts of the installation shall be earthed properly.

Entire job of installation shall be done as per the instruction on site by our Engineer-in-charge and is subject to changes felt by the Engineer-in-charge, if required. Payment for any additional work shall be made as per the quoted rate.

The bidder is to visit the site for estimation of the volume of job and quantity of materials required. Actual quantity (for final payment) shall be finalized after execution of the complete work and measurement to be done jointly by this institute and the party.




MAJOR TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Competent authority reserves the right to cancel the tender, postpone the date of receipt and opening the tender or redefine the volume of work without assigning any reason what-so-ever or any clarification or notification to the parties. Competent authority reserves the right to reduce the volume of work even after the award of job and payment shall be made according to the actual volume of work executed and as per quoted rate.
2. Competent authority reserves the right to terminate the contract in between, in case the supply of materials and the quality of job being done are not satisfactory within seven days' notice either verbally or in writing. No payment shall be made in that case for part supply or part completion of the job done. Further, all changes done in our existing system shall have to be re-modified to the original condition by the party free of cost.
3. Conditional/ incomplete tenders will not be accepted and shall be outright rejected.
4. Issuance of tender documents does not mean that the parties are considered to be qualified.
5. The experience as given in the eligibility criteria should be in the name & style in which tender is filled. The experience in the name of some other firm / company will not be considered for this purpose
6. No offloading or sub-contracting is permissible. If it is reported or found in any stage after opening the offer or even after issuing the work order, the same shall be treated as violation of contract and shall be cancelled and terminated. The bidder shall closely study all terms and conditions in details, which governs the rates for which he/she/they is/are tendering.
7. The company does not bind itself to accept the lowest tender and reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders without assigning any reason whatsoever and split up the work between two or more tenders or accept the tender in part and not in entirety.
8. The rates, terms and conditions offered shall be valid for a period of 180 days from the date of opening of Price Bid / Revised Price Bid (if any). It is the onus of the contractor to have the liability for any compensation to self and his engaged worker / labour in case of eventuality. CMPDI, RI-II will have no liability in any case and in any manner.
9. If the contractor fails to maintain the required progress in terms of agreed time and progress chart or to complete the work and clear the site on or before the contract or extended date of completion he shall without prejudice to any other right or remedy available under the law to the company on account of such breach, pay as compensation (Liquidated damages) @ half percent (1/2%) of the contract price per week of delay. The aggregate of such Compensation shall not exceed 10 (ten) percent of the value as shown in the contract.
10. The party is to give warranty for all components of the installation work under their scope for six months from the date of completion of entire work. During warranty period the successful bidder is to maintain the entire system properly (including the existing portion) and downtime should not exceed more than 24 hours failing which penalty will be deducted from the security deposit @ half percent (1/2%) of the contract price per week. The engineer / electrician of the party should be available at Dhanbad during the warranty period to attend the system in case of any failure or break down of the system.
