2.14 *Warranty:*

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be as given in specifications from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. - (c) Uses sub-components, sub-systems and major assemblies of substantially similar design & construction to the model quoted - only rating specifications may differ (Lower or Higher)**

In case the bidder claims provenness of the quoted model based on similar equipment and the similar equipment has performed satisfactorily for a minimum period of one year from the date of commissioning, but the quoted model has not worked for a minimum period of six months, the offer may be accepted subject to the conditions mentioned under here under :

i) The 100% Additional Performance Bank Guarantee for the equipment/first lot (if applicable) shall be encashed by CMPDI. Consequent upon the encashment of the 100% Bank Guarantee due to non-achievement of stipulated minimum availability percentage, the Supplier shall take back the equipment at no cost to the Purchaser and the contract for the balance quantity shall be cancelled.
